

## Compressor Rules

Club tanks get priority

**We will not fill bottles which are out of test under any circumstances**

Tanks will be filled on a first come, first served order

Due to time considerations **we cannot guarantee an immediate fill**

If a member brings more than 1 bottle, **any extra bottles will be filled at the end of the session if there is time**

We will not keep members empty bottles overnight. If we have not been able to fill your bottle, you will be given a voucher that entitles you to a free fill on the next fill night

When you bring your tank along for filling:

- Buy/get a ticket and place around the neck of your cylinder
- Place the tank in a organised line where directed
- Filled tanks will have tickets removed and then will be placed at the collection point
- If there is a problem with the tank speak to either the tank filler or the leader that night
- If there is a problem with the tank fill, speak to the Compressor Safety Officer or a Compressor Leader as soon as possible

Tickets can be bought from:

- Compressor Safety Officer
- Equipment Officer
- Treasurer or Chairperson
- Compressor Leader on the night

We will try to operate the compressor every **Wednesday (7pm – 8pm)** and **Thursday (tbc)**, but this may be changed with consultation with Aireborough Leisure Centre. Days and times can be checked with the Compressor Safety Officer or the Compressor Leaders.
